## **ABOUT DIRECT PAYMENTS**

A Direct Payment is a cash payment made to individuals who have been assessed as needing services.

The aim of a direct payment is to increase choice and flexibility for service users, giving them control of the service that they receive. Direct Payments enable the service user, and in the case of children, their parents to:

- Choose who they employ
- Decide when the employee will work
- Choose how the employee will work

The Direct Payment team offer a wide range of support services to over 400 service users with a diverse range of needs. The support offered includes regular advice and support on all areas of managing a direct payment and being a responsible employer. This includes support with the recruitment and selection of personal assistants, arranging training programmes, responding to payroll and Her Majesties Revenue and Customs (HMRC) enquiries and advising on employee management issues.

Following referral from your social worker a Direct Payment Advisor will meet you to discuss Direct Payments in more detail.

Sure Start Children's Centres in Trafford are just the place where families with children under 5 can access services and information from a range of different professionals.

As well as 9 local Trafford Sure Start Children's Centres across the borough and an Information point at Greatstone Library, there are now 5 new information points in Urmston, Sale Central, Ashton on Mersey, Hale Barns and Bowdon & Hale as part of Trafford's Phase 3 development of children's centres. These are providing information, services, support and activities for thousands of local families.

Staff recognise that all families and their needs are different, which is why each centre offers a slightly different service. Many sessions and groups are free, while others like the stay and play sessions may carry a small charge of around £1.

Some of the services currently available include:-

Drop-in/stay and play. Baby massage. Toddler Gym. Story/Rhyme sessions. Links to Job Centre Plus and Community Living. Links to Children & Young People's Information Service (CYPIS). Parenting Groups for support with children's safety, sleep and behaviour e.g. Incredible Years, Speech and Language support. Family Support,.

Chatterbox programme aims to encourage early language development through simple play activities that can be reproduced in the family home.

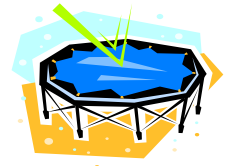

## LINK RECORD UPDATE

The 1989 Children's Act requires all local authorities to maintain a 'register' of children with disabilities in their area so future services can be planned and developed according to need.

In Trafford this Register is called 'LINK' or Children's Disability Record.

It provides information about health, welfare and educational needs of children and young people up to the age of 19. Inclusion on the Record is voluntary.

Registration will help the communication process between families, local authority, health and voluntary agencies.

Thank you to all parents /carers who have included their child/children on the Record and help with the bi-annual reviews which are essential to keep the Record up-to-date

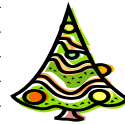
